

ABSTRACT INSTRUCTIONS

Each abstract should contain:

- a sentence stating the study objective (unless given in the title);
- a brief statement of methods, if pertinent;
- a summary of the results obtained;
- and a statement of the conclusions. It is not satisfactory to say "the results will be discussed."

Abstract Title and Body:

- Enter the title of your abstract in Title Case (i.e. cap the first letter of each word, except prepositions). Do not put a period at the end of the abstract title.
- Capitalize initial letters of trade names.
- Use standard abbreviations for units of measure.
- Other abbreviations should be spelled out in full at first mention, followed by the abbreviation in parentheses. Exceptions: DNA, RNA, etc.
- Include the source of research support.
- The abstract title, authors, affiliations and body of the abstract should not exceed 3000 characters excluding spaces.
- If your abstract contains tables, graphics or figures, upload your abstract as a pdf.
